14A CHARTER RESOLUTION TO AMEND ARTICLE VII "REGISTRATION, 15NOMINATION AND ELECTION PROCEDURES" SECTION 702 "VOTERS" TO 16AMEND MINIMUM AGE PROVISION UNDER WHICH A VOTER IS ALLOWED 17TO VOTE IN CITY ELECTIONS

19**WHEREAS**, the City of Glenarden is a municipal corporation of the State of Maryland, 20operating under Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland and §4-301 *et seq.* of the 21Local Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended; and 22

23**WHEREAS**, Section 702 of the Charter now grants the right to vote in City elections to 24any citizen who has reached the age of 16, has been a resident for the 30 days immediately 25preceding the next City election, and has registered in accordance with the provisions of 26this; and

27

28**WHEREAS,** the State of Maryland affords youth who are U.S. citizens and residents of 29this state, the right to register to vote at the age of 16, but cannot legally vote until the age 30of 18; and

32**WHEREAS,** Citizens voiced their concerns with not being notified of the proposed change 33to the City Charter that would lower the voting age from 18 to 16 years old for City 34elections.

36**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED** that Section 702 "Voters 37of the Charter of the City of Glenarden be repealed, re-enacted and amended to read as 38follows:

39Section 702 Voters

40Every person who meets all the following requirements may vote in City elections: 41

42(a) Is a citizen of the United States;

43(b) Is at least [16] 18 years of age;

44(c) Has resided in the corporate limits of the City for the 30 days immediately preceding 45the next City election;

46(d) Is registered in accordance with the provisions of this Charter.
